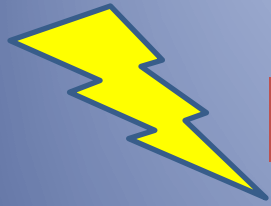


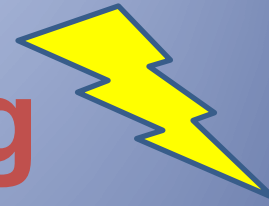

## **October 1995**

# August 1998 - Aspen

13 councils - 2nd National Ski Council Summit

Kim Miller – Florida and Anne Myers – Texas Organized

Paul Webber (Cleveland) solicits 9 new councils

Returnees - Chicago, Far West, Florida & Texas

9 New Councils – Bay Area, Blue Ridge, Cleveland, LA, Crescent, Detroit, Milwaukee, New Jersey, & Ohio Valley

## Decision

Form National Ski Council Federation (NSCF)

## Goal:

*Enabling better communication between Councils (networking), resorts, and tour operators, and to become a stronger voice within the travel & snow sports industry.*

## **August 1999**

**23 Councils convene 1st NSCF meeting in **Park City**  
10 new Councils brought the total to 23**

### **Decisions:**

**By-laws and First Election**

#### **10 New Councils:**

**Arizona, E. Pennsylvania, Flatland,  
Minnesota, Metro New York,  
National Brotherhood of Skiers,  
Northwest, Orange, San Diego, and  
W. Pennsylvania**

- 1999 - Created bylaws and held our first elections for 3 officers, President, Vice President/Treasurer & Secretary.
- 2000 - Adopted our first logo
- 2000 - First Eastern resort host (& only to date)
- 2004 - First & Only European Business Meeting
- 2004 - Office Vice President/Treasurer split into two offices.
- 2005 - Mission statement amended to include Industry Partners
- 2009 - First International Spring Education meeting held in Grindlewald, Switzerland
- 2012 - Announced our new logo
- 2013 - Launch of new website scheduled for late autumn/early winter.
