



HISTORY OF CRESCENT SKI COUNCIL 1969 to 2009 (taken from Charlotte Ski Bees newsletters)

Crescent Ski Council (“CSC”) was formed on February 10, 1969. The original Clubs were the **Greensboro, Charlotte, Raleigh and Durham-Chapel Hill clubs**. The purpose of CSC was to promote skiing and fellowship and plan trips to resort areas.

The first trip of CSC was not a ski trip, but a **trip to Freeport in the Bahamas**. The dates of the Bahamas trip were August 14-17, 1969, and the all-inclusive cost was \$142/person, with 82 spaces available. Flight was charter.

From the 1970-71 Charlotte Ski Bees (“Ski Bees”) Handbook, the member clubs were now at 8 and included Raleigh, Winston-Salem, Asheville, Greenville, Columbia, Richmond, Roanoke and Charlotte. The Chairman was David Hogg of Raleigh. A list of the 1969 Board of Directors is included in the Ski Bees Handbook.

Sandy Mitchell of Charlotte Ski Bees provided the following information to Pat Harvey in 2009:

“Actually, I can’t believe it’s been 40 years. Ralph [Tate] and I would drive to the other ski club meetings, from Greensboro to Greenville and Columbia, always driving late into the night to get back home and try to sell them on Crescent for trips and racing. We would put on a presentation at their meetings to try and convince them to join Crescent. They would always put us on as the last agenda item for their programs and by then people were getting tired and ready to leave. Once they found out all we had to offer they signed right up.

Ralph came up with the name Crescent because if you drew on a map a line from these clubs and through Charlotte it was in the shape of a crescent moon. Later Raleigh and some of the other clubs came on board. They quickly learned it was better and cheaper to go to Europe and out West with a larger number of people than they could pull from their smaller clubs. Ever since then things just kept on growing. Jim Cogdell also helped some and Little Travel Agency became the agent of choice. Little Travel also helped a lot by giving out goodies to the people on the trip. Ralph was tour guide on a lot of these trips, and I did one also. Have you ever tried to baby sit 150 people and make sure they were all there when the buses and planes left? Ralph designed the Crescent pin and logo.”

- A CSC weekend was held at the Holiday Inn in Boone, NC on February 13-15, 1970. Each Club had 14 rooms. Ski Races were held at Sugar Mt. and a dance was scheduled for Saturday night.
- A ski trip was scheduled to Aspen for March 21-18, 1970. Cost was \$230. Lodging at Snowmass and ski at Aspen, Buttermilk, Aspen Highland and Snowmass. Departure was from Greensboro. MasterCard and Bank Americard were accepted for payment for an additional charge of \$6. Wes Doggett of Greensboro was Trip Leader. Participants included 36 from Greensboro, 9 from Richmond, 9 from Winston-Chapel Hill, 2 from Winston-Salem, 1 from Richmond and 18 from Charlotte. Less than 20 spots were available by 10/69. Lodging was at the Wildwood Inn at Snowmass.
- Member Clubs now included Greensboro, Raleigh, Durham-Chapel-Hill, Winston-Salem, Richmond, Roanoke and Charlotte. Richmond and Roanoke joined CSC as of 9/69.



- December 28, 1969, CSC scheduled a trip to Jackson Hole, WY.
- February 28, 1970, CSC scheduled a trip to Mt. Snow. The cost was \$160-190. Lodging was at the Mountaineer. Deposit was \$10.
- Crescent patches were offered in February 1970 at a cost of \$1/each and were available for purchase from Ralph Tate.
- A trip was scheduled to Montego Bay, Jamaica for 8/20/70 at a cost of \$220.
- A CSC BOD meeting was held April 25, 1970 in Gatlinburg. Asheville, Durham-Chapel Hill, Greensboro, Raleigh, Winston-Salem and Charlotte clubs were present. Dave Hogg was CSC Chairman for 2 years. Ralph Tate was Secretary.
- A Ski-Jamboree was held on 2/20-22/70 at Sugar Mt. and included inter-club ski races. President for the coming year was elected. Bob Wearn of Winston-Salem was elected.
- CSC meeting was held in June 1970 in Winston-Salem. Catawba Valley submitted application for membership in CSC. CSC was now up to 11 clubs from the states of Virginia, North Carolina and South Carolina for a total membership of 2,000.
- March 12-28, 1971, CSC scheduled a European trip to St. Anton and Davos for 195 participants. The cost was \$465/person and the trip coordinator was Ralph Tate. The trip was later changed due to lack of signups to 8 days to Switzerland at a cost of \$330/person.
- CSC meeting was held 5/23/71 at the Holiday Inn West in Asheville. 13 Clubs attended. RSOC was formed. Membership requests came in from several Clubs including Wilmington. Chairman was Dave Hogg. Jim Cogdell was elected Chairman for the coming year and Ralph Tate was appointed Trip Director. Upcoming trips included Vail at Christmas for a cost of \$300 and Cervino, Italy the first week in March for a cost of \$385. Participation in a CSC trip required 6-month membership in a member Club. Non-sponsored trip was scheduled to Crested Butte, 3/18-25/72.
- CSC Meeting was held 6/27/71 in Greensboro. 12 Clubs were present. Capital Ski Club from Raleigh changed its name to the Sir Walter Ski Club. The meetings were reduced to 2 per year. Spartanburg was expelled for non-payment and non-participation. The Linville Club was disbanded. Club dues ranged from \$5-20 for an average of \$8. Clubs now included Charlotte, Richmond, Durham-Chapel Hill, Columbia, Hickory, Raleigh, Greeneville, TN, Greenville, SC and Winston-Salem.
- Next year's trips were announced in August 1971 to Munich, Germany to Kitzbuhl, Davos and St. Moritz.
- CSC SkiLiner for 9/71 has the beach trip first suggested. Winston-Salem Club was originally named Sitzmark. Durham-Chapel Hill was in its 3rd season and had 314 members. The Nat Greene Ski Club was out of Greensboro. Charlotte Ski Bees had 400 members, Greeneville, TN had 60 member, and the Sir Walter Ski Club in Raleigh had 160 members.
- CSC met on 2/6/71 at Sugar Mt. The Greeneville, TN club was suspended due to no participation. Danville, VA and Wilmington, NC Clubs were admitted as members for a total now of 13 member clubs. 1973 trips were scheduled to Vail, Jackson Hole, and Munich, Germany.
- Two Crested Butte trips were scheduled for 1971: 3/20/71 out of Charlotte and 2/27/71 out of Greensboro for a total cost of \$244.21. These trips were run by Crested Butte.



- 2nd Summer Holiday at Freeport, Bahamas was scheduled for 8/12-15/71 for a cost of \$169. Ralph Tate was the Trip Leader.
- CSC SkiLiner in the 11/72 newsletter shows Jim Cogdell as President. Charleston and Spartanburg (reinstatement) applied for membership for a total of 15 clubs. Spartanburg's request for reinstatement was denied.
- Vail trip scheduled for 12/15/72 was a charter ski trip with Ralph Tate as Trip Leader.
- CSC SkiLiner was included in the 2/73 newsletter: 12/9/72 meeting of CSC was held in Winston-Salem. Alamance Ski Club, Burlington, NC, and Central Virginia Ski Club from Lynchburg were accepted as provincial members. Jim Cogdell was CSC Chairman.
- SkiLiner for 4/73 listed Jim Cogdell as President, Ralph Tate as Trip Director and a membership of 16 clubs.
- 1973-74 Trips were: Vail 12/15-23; Snowmass 1/19-27; Davos, Switzerland 1/31-2/10 and Jackson Hole 3/2-9/74.
- CSC meeting for 6/73 was hosted in Charlotte by Ski Bees.
- CSC 1974 Annual Meeting: Ernie Spangler of Nat Greene Ski Club of Greensboro was elected Chairman. Virginia Ski Club of Richmond withdrew as member due to the formation of the Virginia Ski Council. Central Virginia Ski Club of Lynchburg associate memberships was terminated. North Augusta Ski Club was interested in joining.
- March 1974 Crescent Cup was new.
- The 1974-75 trips were to Vail 12/19-28, Vail 1/18-25, Snowmass 1-25-2/1, Salt Lake City with skiing in Park City and Alta 2/1-8 and Calgary 3/15-23.
- 7/74 SkiLiner listed Ernie Spangler of Nat Greene Ski Club as Chairman for a 2nd term and Ralph Tate as Trip Director.
- CSC 1975 Annual meeting was to be held at the Breakers in Myrtle Beach.
- CSC weekend trip to Sugar was held 1/30-1/1/76.
- CSC Beach trip was held at the Holiday Inn, Myrtle Beach 5/21-23/76
- 1977 trips were to: Vail for Christmas; Snowmass 1/15/77, Snowmass 1/22/77, Innsbruck 2/10/77, Jackson Hole 2/26/77, and Vail 3-5-12/77
- 1978 trips were to Snowmass 2/4/78 and Vail 3/4/78 and a Christmas trip to Vail. Sun Valley/Jackson Hole trip scheduled for 3/11/78, Aspen 1/28/78, and Vail 2/25/78. John Watkins was Trip Director.
- CSC Beach trip was held 9/23-25/77 at the Ocean Dunes in Myrtle Beach.
- Crescent Spring Beach weekend was scheduled for 5/19-20/78 at Ocean Dunes, Myrtle Beach.
- Crescent Fall Beach trip for 1978 was held 9/15-16/78 – lodging was at Howard Johnson's in Myrtle Beach. Cost was \$26/night per person.
- Crescent trips for 1979 were scheduled: Vail, 3/3/79, Snowmass, 3/10/79. John Watkins was the Trip Director.



- 1/79 newsletter listed 20 Clubs now in CSC.
- 1/79 CSC SkiLiner shows CSC Chair as Sharilyn Cone and John Watkins as Trip Director.
- CSC Beach trip for 5/11/79 was held at Regency Towers in Myrtle Beach. Cost was \$24/night per person.
- CSC trips for 1980/81 were scheduled: Charlotte to Vail, 3/1/81, 80 participants at a cost of \$408 with lodging at Vail Village Inn; Charlotte to Aspen dates were 1/26. Cost was \$512/person; Winston-Salem and Raleigh also had trips (trip destinations not listed).
- 10/79 minutes for Ski Bees report that Gordon Vail received a letter from CSC proposing scheduling meetings on a quarterly basis.
- CSC weekend was scheduled for 2/1-3/80.
- Beach Weekend for 5/30-6/1/80 was scheduled at Howard Johnson's, Myrtle Beach for a cost of \$34/night per person.
- 1980/81 Trips scheduled were:
 - 12/7/80 to Vail
 - 1/24/81 to Aspen
 - 1/31/81 to Ski the Summit
 - 2/7/81 to Jackson Hole
 - 3/7/81 to Snowmass
 - 3/14/81 to Vail
 - 3/21/81 to Snowmass
- CSC Weekend at Snowshow, 1/23-26/81 for cost of \$160/person. Ken Lumsden, Winston-Salem, organized the first SkiFest. This was the first 3-day weekend allowed at Snowshoe.
- August 1980 newsletter contains front-page article on the death of Ralph Tate who died on 7/11/80 of a heart attack. He was one of the founders of Charlotte Ski Bees and started CSC.
- CSC Fall Beach Weekend was held 9/19-21/80.
- CSC Spring Beach Weekend was scheduled for 5/29-31/81 with lodging at Howard Johnson's for cost of \$50/night per person.
- CSC Fall Beach weekend was scheduled for 9/18-20/81 with lodging at Howard Johnson's, Myrtle Beach.
- CSC Ski Fest was held 2/26-3/1/82 and Southern Star Classic was held 2/8/82.
- 5/21-23/82 CSC Spring Beach weekend was held – lodging was at Place at the Beach Condos in North Myrtle Beach at a cost of \$80/night per person.
- CSC Fall Beach Weekend was held 10/8-10/82 and lodging was at the Landmark Inn in Myrtle Beach.
- 12/82 Ski Bees newsletter includes CSC race rules for 1982-83.
- Snowshoe SkiFest 2/24-27/83. April Briggs Curtis (Raleigh) led the trip.



- CSC Spring beach trip was 6/10-12/83 and lodging was at the Landmark Inn, Myrtle Beach for a cost of \$150-184.
- The July 1983 Ski Bee newsletter reported that Crescent met and trips this year will be handled through Little Travel.
- CSC Fall Beach weekend was 9/30-10/2/83 at the Landmark Inn, Myrtle Beach – Cost was \$37.50 - \$56.
- Snowshoe SkiFest is reported as held 2/24-2/27/84. Records indicate that SkiFest was offered for only three years: 1981, 1982 and 1983.
- CSC Spring Beach weekend was held 6/1-3/84 and the lodging was at the Sands Beach Club, North Myrtle Beach. Cost was \$50 and \$37/night per person.
- CSC Fall Beach weekend was held 10/5-7/84 and lodging was at the Sands Beach Club, North Myrtle Beach.
- 9/84 Ski Bees newsletter contains flyer on CSC First Annual Race Clinic to be held at Keystone, 12-2-8/84. Cost was \$785 and it was run by Accent on Travel, travel agent in Charlotte and Trip Leader was Dave Eudy of Charlotte Ski Bees.
- 9/84 Ski Bees newsletter has article on CSC Winter Trip schedule:

- Not a CSC event but on Labor Day Weekend, 1984, Dr. Tom Brigham invited Charlotte Ski Bees to a weekend in Snowshoe. Cost was \$20/person and 10 Ski Bees participated (Pat Harvey was one of them). The weekend included lodging at Whistlepunk, BBQ dinner and of course the opportunity to meet and socialize for a weekend with Dr. Brigham, the “Father of Southern Skiing” who was the dentist who founded Sugar, Beech and Snowshoe Mountains.
- CSC Spring Weekend, 5/4-6/85 – Lodging was at Ocean Creek Condos in Myrtle Beach. Article says, “Atlanta joining us.”
- 8/85 Ski Bees newsletter has article on 2nd Annual Keystone Race Camp scheduled for 12/8-13/85. Dave Eudy was Race Director
- 1986 CSC Trips: Steamboat, 2/22-3/1/86 and Quebec 1/11-18/86.
- CSC Fall 1985 Beach Weekend, 9/20-22/85 at Myrtle Beach Resorts, Myrtle Beach at cost of \$55/person.
- CSC Mega Ski Trip scheduled to Dillon, CO, 1/25-2/1/86
- CSC Steamboat trip scheduled for 2/22-3/1/86 with Charlotte, Columbia and Knoxville participating.



- CSC Spring Beach trip 1986, dates 5/2-4/86 at Myrtle Beach Resorts, Myrtle Beach. Theme was Mexican Fiesta and 2,000 were expected and over 25 major ski resorts represented. Cost was \$60/person.
- 2/86 CSC became affiliated with two national organizations – more details to be given later (although never found further info. in Ski Bee newsletters).
- March 1986 newsletter for Ski Bees contains January 1986 SkiLiner. Report on New Snowshoe given by David Tanner, Marketing Director for Whistlepunk Village. Reported that in 1986 Snowshoe was in and out of Chapter 11. Lift tickets at Snowshoe reduced to \$25 for weekends and \$21 for mid-week. CSC Trip Program report for 1985/86 was given – Tom Broughton was Trip Chairman. Reported Keystone Race Camp held 12/8-14/85 was a success and will be offered next year.
- Trips for 1986/87:
 - Christmas at Vail – 12/21-28
 - Quebec City/Sainte Anne – 1/11-18
 - Mega trip 1/25-2/1 – 400-450 signed up with 7 commercial flights leaving from NC, SC, TN and GA to Dillon, CO. Sunday ski at Arahapoe, Monday at Copper - \$21 lift ticket, Tuesday at Breckenridge for \$17 lift ticket, Wednesday at Vail for \$22 lift ticket; Thursday, CSC Race at Keystone and Friday on your own to favorite order. There were 4 organizers: Steve Smith, Jim Morgan, Vince Herron and Tom Broughton.
 - Snowmass – 2/2-9 – 139 participants mostly from RSOC
 - Steamboat 2/22-3/1 organized by Jane Brissette, Columbia Ski Club President, and trip was mostly Columbia and Atlanta.
 - Jackson Hole – 2 trips – (1) from Greenville 2/8 charter flight with lodging at Sojourner Inn, and (2) from Chattanooga on 2/16. Sojourn Travel of Charleston, WV handled.
 - 3 options for a European trip:
 - Trip A&B: St. Anton, Austria continuing to Vienna for 3 nights. Tom Broughton TL.
 - Trip C: 7 nights in Pettnau, town which is 3 miles from St. Anton. Ken Lumsden TL
- Tom Broughton ended his term as CSC Trip Director. In fall EXCOMM meeting, Denver Board appointed Jane Brissette as Trip Director to succeed Tom. A Trip Committee of 6 people was formed: Dave Taylor from WSSOC, Chris Fiege of Knoxville, Linda Doyle from Nashville, John Casey from Palmetto and Sandra Griffin from RSOC. and Jane Brissette from Columbia.
- Winterscene at Wintergreen was held 1/9-11/87 for a cost of \$122/person
- Spring Fling at Wintergreen was held 2/27-3/1/87.
- CSC European/Canada Trips for 1986/87:
 - Val D'Isere/Tignes – 1/16/87 – TO was Lynx Tours.
 - Kitzbuhl, Austria, 1/30-2/8/87. LTA Travel handling. 7 nights in Kitzbuhl and 1 night layover in Munich.
 - Quebec, 1/6-11/87 - \$364 for 5 days.



- Greenwood Ski Club had a 12/20-27/86 Christmas trip to Park City for cost of \$725. Trip Leader was Everett Bedenbaugh and the trip was run by LTA Travel.
- In 12/86 (from the Ski Bee newsletter), the CSC SkiLiner changed to an abbreviated version to be run as a column in Club's newsletters.
- CSC President for 1986/87 was Vince Herran.
- CSC Winter Meeting was held 12/20/86 at Appalachian.
- Spring Fling at Wintergreen scheduled for 2/27-3/1/87. On 2/28 an interclub Allstar race scheduled.
- From the 2/87 newsletter Ski Bee BOD minutes, Crescent will take about 1200 skiers this year on trips.
- CSC Spring Beach weekend was held 5/1-3/87 and lodging was at the Sea Mist Hotel in Myrtle Beach for a cost of \$170-270.
- CSC Fall Convention scheduled 9/4-6/87 was "Cruise to Nowhere" to be held on the water instead of at the beach. Cruise departed Charleston and cost was \$170-245. Date was later changed to 9/11-13/87 and trip was arranged through Sovereign Travel. Pictures of the 1987 Cruise to Nowhere are in 10/87 Ski Bee newsletter.
- Winterscene at Winterplace was held 1/8-10/88 at cost of \$157.
- CSC Spring beach trip on 4/29-5/1/88 was held at Sea Mist in Myrtle Beach – 30 major ski resorts reps. Were expected to attend. Theme was PJ Party and cost was \$38 with 4 to a room and \$76 with 2 to a room.
- CSC Fall Beach Weekend was held 9/30-10/1/88 at the Sea Mist in Myrtle Beach. Cost was \$43 to \$65.
- Crescent Jellyfish instructions were published in the 10/88 Ski Bee newsletter.
- CSC Spring Fling Beach Trip was held 4/28-30/89 with a Thursday option offered (no location listed) and was CSC's 20th Anniversary.
- An article "In Memoriam" was published in the July 1989 Ski Bee Newsletter regarding Tom Broughton who died 5/14/89.
- CSC Fall Beach weekend was held 10/19-22/89 at the Sea Mist in Myrtle Beach. Attendance was listed at topping 650.
- Crescent Ski Week held 1/13-20/90 – LTA was the TO. Lodging was at Timber Run and the Lodge. NASTAR races held for everyone.
- Ski New England/Sugarbush trip was held 3/10-14/90. LTA handled. Cost was \$495.
- Spring Beach Weekend was held in Hilton Head, 4/27-29-90. \$63 each (Post Hurricane Hugo. **Hugo was in September 1989, and the beaches had not yet recovered as of April 1990.**) Offsite fee was \$30.
- Fall Beach Weekend was in Hilton Head. Theme was "Mad Hatter's Ball). Pricing ranged from \$66 to 101.



- From 10/90 Ski Bee minutes, CSC is looking at alternating between Hilton Head and Myrtle Beach for the spring and fall beach weekends.
- CSC Trips: Banff 1/19/91 at cost of \$979 and Mt. Tremblant and Villa Bellevue 3/17/91 at cost of \$729.
- CSC Spring Beach weekend 4/26-28/91 was held at Hilton Head for cost of \$70-\$107. Offsite fee was \$35. Theme was “Costume Party”. Non-members were \$10 additional. Charlotte Ski Bees took 2nd place in scrapbook competition.
- National Leadership Advisory Board meeting held in Charlotte 8/17/91. According to Ken Lumsden’s notebook from that event, it was called the “Crescent Ski Council Club Officers Training Program and it was held at the Holiday Inn in Cornelius, NC (Lake Norman). The “National Leadership Advisory Board” was a predecessor of the Crescent Officers Training Program.” Crescent leaders who went to the NLAB meeting, and then founded the “Crested Butte Advisory Board,” were Denver Board (Charlotte Bees), Jane Brissette (Columbia Ski Club), Taleta “T” Dyson (Atlanta Ski Club), Warren Frederick (New Orleans), Jim Maher (New Jersey Ski Council), Marylee Robison (Tulsa Ski Club and Flatland Ski Association), Don Thomas (Texas Ski Council and San Antonio Ski Club) and Debbie Fox & Pauli Portenier-Bucannan (Crested Butte Mountain Resort). In Ken Lumsden’s opinion, the NLAB can, with the benefit of hindsight, be considered somewhat of a predecessor of the National Ski Council Federation. Ken was chairman of Crescent when Crescent became a charter member of NSCF in 1998. Mini workshops were included for Crescent. \$26/workshop fee and \$10 for BBQ Dinner.
- Fall Beach weekend 9/19-22/91 was held at Hilton Head Beach & Tennis Resort at a cost of \$73-\$110. Theme was Pajama Party.
- Whistler trip schedule 3/7-14/92 through LTA. Charlotte and Greensboro were the main clubs participating. Cost was \$879 to \$1056.
- CSC Spring beach weekend scheduled for 4/24-26/92 at Hilton head. Over 1,000 were expected to attend from 25 clubs. Theme was “Dress as your favorite sport.”
- Spring Beach weekend 4/23-25/93 was held at Radisson Kings Point in Myrtle Beach.
- CSC Ski Trips for 1994: 1/15-22/94 to Jackson Hole with lodging on the mountain at price of \$865. Heavenly/Lake Tahoe scheduled for 3-12-19/94 with lodging at Lakeland Village for a cost of \$845. LTA handling.
- Crescent Fall Beach weekend, 9/17-19/93 at Holiday Inn Oceanfront Downtown in Myrtle Beach. Note says “cancelled – believe Ski Bees didn’t have enough participation). Theme was western night.
- Steamboat Race Camp scheduled for 12/4-11/93 for 7-day trip at \$562/person; 12/9-14/93 was 3-day trip at cost of \$389/person. Lodging, lift tickets and lessons were included.
- CSC Mega trip was scheduled to Gray Rocks, Canada, 2/5-12/94 – “Cruise on Skis”. Cost \$645-\$745 and air approximately \$320.
- Ski the Summit trip to Breckenridge, 2/11-18/94. Lodging was at Wedgewood Lodge Condos and cost was \$799.



- At 2/13/95 Ski Bee meeting, Ken Lumsden, of CSC and Winston-Salem Ski Club, was the speaker for a program on “Introduction to Crescent Ski Council.” CSC had 10,000 associated members. Ken showed slides of Ski Bees at Crescent events.
- CSC SkiLiner is in 3/95 Ski Bees newsletter.
- CSC 25th Anniversary Spring Beach trip was held 4/28-5/1/94 at Hilton Head. Theme was “Space, the Final Frontier.”
- CSC Fall Beach Weekend was held 9/15-18/94 and lodging was at the Myrtle Beach Hilton.
- CSC presented UVEX Celebrity Ski Cruise, 10/1-8/94 for a cost of \$999 plus \$104 port taxes. There were 50 participants and cruise was run by South Florida Cruises. The “Cruise to Nowhere” was in lieu of a Fall Conference. [Some clubs (e.g., Winston-Salem, went to the beach anyway, but Crescent was not involved.)]
- CSC’s Mega Trip for 1995 was to Breckenridge, 1/28-2/4/95 at cost of \$785. Lisa Beregi was the Trip Coordinator and LTA handled.
