As you know, both the EPIC & IKON Passes went on sale March 6th. Lisa received a very good question this week about the EPIC Pass and how much if you buy one you would save on the Crested Butte January Ski Week. Although we haven't finalized the Crested Butte pricing, the lift ticket portion will be the same. 5-day lift ticket included in the package is \$214, so if one has the EPIC pass, they can deduct that amount from the trip. Remember, if you buy your EPIC pass from SAT you will get an additional \$30 or \$50 off the trip depending on which pass you purchase.

The only flexible component to that price is we will be offering a Monarch Day Trip during the week at an additional day trip fee. So - if one wanted to go to Monarch but only ski 5 days total, they would only be purchasing a 4-day Crested Butte ticket and the savings would be less.

Sara Clemons at Sports America also forwarded the below links on the EPIC Passes being offered for active and retired military (and dependents) for \$99 and the discounted pass offered to any vet! **These cannot be purchased through SAT, so share with your clubs. The Military Passes are only good at Vail resorts, not partners, so they would not be valid at Crested Butte, Telluride or A-Basin.** Please read all the FAQs associated with each type of pass.

RECIPROCAL MEMBERSHIPS FOR TRIPS

We know that some of the Clubs have trips during the off-season months and the 2018/19 trips will start rolling out by the Clubs starting in May. Reminder, Crescent doesn't mandate that member Clubs offer reciprocity on Club trips, but we do recommend that our member Clubs allow members of other Crescent Clubs to participate in their trips and offer a reciprocal membership to the member of another Crescent Club to participate on trips offered by member Clubs. The suggested wording is as follows:

Reciprocal membership is available to persons twenty-one (21) years of age and older who are currently a member in good standing in a Crescent Ski Council Club other than [name of Club]. The reciprocal member shall not be entitled to vote. If a Crescent member in good standing participates in a [name of Club] hosted activity, that person will be charged a \$1.00 membership fee and become a [name of Club] guest member during the activity.

We hope that Clubs will open their trips to other Crescent Club members without the necessity for the member to become a full member of that Club.
